Lessig addresses the role and corrupting influence of money on the United State's representative democracy, and proposes a radical solution to money in politics: a state-driven U.S. constitutional amendment to make all public elections exclusively publicly funded. FRI. JAN 27 - 7:00 PM - "INTO ETERNITY" THIS HIDING PLACE SHOULD NEVER BE

DISTURBED. Every day, the world over, large amounts of high-level radioactive waste created by nuclear power plants is placed in interim storage, which is vulnerable to natural disasters, man-made disasters, and to societal changes. In Finland the world's first permanent repository is being hewn out of solid rock - a huge system of underground tunnels - that must last 100,000 years as this is how long the waste remains hazardous. sealed off and never opened again. Will it endure? (Film: 75 min, Michael Madsen, 2010)

FRI. FEB 3 - 7:00 PM - "2012 - TIME FOR CHANGE" CONSCIOUS EVOLUTION TO PRACTICAL SOLUTIONS. An optimistic alternative to apocalyptic doom and gloom. The film follows journalist Daniel Pinchbeck, author of the bestselling *2012: The Return of Quetzalcoatl*, on a quest for a new paradigm that integrates the archaic wisdom of tribal cultures with the scientific method. Can 2012 herald the birth of a regenerative planetary culture that replaces the sterile materialism that has pushed our world to the brink? (Film: 85 min, Joao G. Amorim , 2010)
